

Code of Conduct

Directors and senior managers of Community CPS Australia Group companies will:

1. Comply with the spirit as well as the letter of all laws, voluntary codes of practice and this Code;
2. Retain their independence in judgement and actions and take all reasonable steps to be satisfied as to the soundness, integrity and justice of their decisions;
3. Act primarily in the best interests of Community CPS members as a whole, while having regard where appropriate for their duties to other stakeholders;
4. Perform their role and use the authority of their position honestly, in good faith and for proper purposes;
5. Use due care and diligence in fulfilling their responsibilities;
6. Maintain confidentiality and not allow any information to be improperly disclosed;
7. Use information acquired through their position only for its proper use;
8. Not take improper advantage of their position;
9. Properly manage any conflict of interests between themselves and the organisation;
10. Not engage in any conduct likely to bring the Community CPS Australia Group into disrepute;
11. Ensure they are qualified to act in the office they hold and inform Community CPS Australia Group immediately if they become ineligible to hold that office.
